




# Mme Tussaud's

There were celebrities like Michael Jackson, the Royal Family, singers and politicians.


There is a scary corridor and 4D cinema .


# Weather, Food and Families

It didn't rain except on Thursday morning.


In the families, we ate cereal and orange juice in the morning.
